

Hall of Fame Inductees Announced

Every year, the Cougar Foundation undertakes the annual process of reviewing nominations for the Sahuaro High School Cougar Foundation Hall of Fame, which honors students, staff, alumni, and other members of the Sahuaro community who have demonstrated good citizenship, strong character, integrity, and who have contributed significantly to the Sahuaro and greater community.

Each year we are lucky to have a number of exceptional nominees and this year is no different - we are proud to announce the induction of Gary Vilas (class of 1981), and Mark Diebolt (class of 1976). We are eager to honor the class of 2023 on November 11th (see page 2 for details) but in the meantime, please read more about them below.



Gary is a Sahuaro graduate class of 1981. Gary was an outstanding student as well as a superior cross country and track competitor. He led the boys cross country team to 2nd place in the 1979 State Meet. Gary still holds the Sahuaro record for the 1500 and 3000 meters in track. Gary finished 2nd in the 3000 meter race in State in 1981. Gary continued his running career at UNLV where he earned his degree in finance. He continues to run and inspire many others as well.

Gary is currently the senior finance and accounting executive for Next Era Energy Resources in Houston. In 2020 Gary was diagnosed with several brain tumors. He has survived many treatments and surgeries. In 2022 Gary ran in San Antonio in the Rock n Roll SK while working full time. Gary loves spending time with his wife, Tommie, and his son, Scott.

A 1976 Sahuaro graduate, Mark was an outstanding football player and wrestler. His senior year Mark was the Flowing Wells tournament champ, Division 1 champ, and State Champ at 138 lbs. Mark graduated from the U of A in 1986 and Western Michigan Law School in 1996. Mark has been a deputy prosecutor for the Pima County Attorney's Office for 26 years. He has been a trial prosecutor for over 300 cases and tried over 50 homicide trials. Mark has been given the Pima County Attorneys Office Community Service Award for his ongoing commitment and dedication to the citizens of Pima County and has been featured on NBC News documentary "In the Jury Room".
