## **Cougar Foundation Senior Scholarship**

### **Application Information Sheet**

The Cougar Foundation Scholarship offers one (1), non-renewable, \$1200 scholarship to a Sahuaro graduating senior. **Submit your application to the Cougar Foundation no later than April 16**.

#### I. In order to be eligible, students must:

- a. Be a U.S. Citizen or permanent resident of the United States.
- b. Have a seven semester, non-weighted cumulative GPA of: 2.5 3.49.
- c. Be a high school senior who will enroll at an accredited two- or four-year college, university or institution of higher learning full-time during the 2018-2019 school year.
- d. Have demonstrated leadership abilities through participating in community service, extra- curricular or other service-based activities.
- e. Have strong motivation to continue their education.

#### II. Required Documentation

- a. Resume please include examples of your leadership, community service, extracurricular or other service-based activities.
- b. Unofficial Transcript An unopened, unofficial copy of the applicant's high school seven semester, non-weighted cumulative, subject-based transcript (not displayed by year) provided by the high school counseling department must be supplied in the application packet. Submission of an application for this scholarship constitutes authorization for the Cougar Scholarship Selection Committee to review your academic record.
- c. Recommendations Each packet must include two (2) letters of recommendation. One of the recommendations must be from a faculty member who has taught the student in the classroom. Each recommendation must include the reference's name, address, telephone number, and information regarding how long and in what capacity he or she has known the applicant and a narrative describing the writer's perception of the ability of the student to succeed in their post-high school endeavor as well as insight regarding the candidate's integrity.
- d. Essay Each candidate must provide a 500-1000-word essay entitled: "My Dreams of the Future" When you look back on your life in thirty years, what would it take for you to consider your life successful? What people, things, and accomplishments do you envision? How does this scholarship fit into your plans to help make that future?
